The Soviet World 1948-1989

Newspapers and periodicals form an important source of information for research on the Soviet Union and the East European countries. Publications from these countries are often particularly difficult to trace.

Furthermore, the search for relevant articles is extremely time consuming and frequently unsuccessful.

The "Amsterdam" bibliography

The bibliography offered here, compiled by the staff of the Institute for Soviet and East European Studies of the University of Amsterdam, offers a good solution to the above problem. It started as early as 1948 to list articles from newspapers and periodicals from both Soviet sources and Western scholarly periodicals covering the Soviet Union and Eastern Europe.

300,000 references from 300 serials on microfiche

The present microfiche edition of the bibliography lists the articles published from 1948 to December 1989.

The bibliography contains about 300,000 references, arranged in an author and a subject card file comprising about 650,000 cards representing a selection made from about 300 serials over a period of 42 years.

Soviet reactions and commentaries on local events are relatively well represented, but there are also articles from the Soviet press dealing with foreign relations and with comments on issues in the West. For instance, the system includes more than 500 references relating to Chernobyl alone.

As a comparison: the annual *European Bibliography of Soviet, East European and Slavic Studies** only lists articles, books, and reviews from Western sources. Moreover publication of that bibliography only commenced in 1975.

Classification system

Because the "Amsterdam" bibliography was originally set up to serve the staff of the institute in Amsterdam, the classification, although quite extensive,

is not as sophisticated as modern databases. Although it is not claimed to be comprehensive, and in spite of its limitations, the bibliography is a veritable goldmine of information spanning 42 years. Once familiar with it, a researcher will find the bibliography easy to use.
